4. Spring Grant Funding and Funding Criteria

A “first pass” was taken at the ORMMap grants using the funding criteria, that can be found on the ORMMap site. An outstanding fund balance over \$80,000 was use to define “large outstanding funds.” After that, DOR looked at grants requesting over \$60,000.

This is not the final version. The Department is projecting a reduction in the fund deposit from last quarter, last quarter’s deposit of \$221,806 was down from the pervious of \$258,925). This will be a larger reduction than I anticipated at first. Until we receive the actual deposit numbers other changes may be need to other grant applications; with that DOR is suggesting the following modifications to address the anticipated difference between fund deposits and grant requests.
